

# **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PATRIOTIC CONCERNED YOUTH ALLIANCE**

## **1. Eligibility**

- Membership shall be open to individuals who accept the objectives, constitution, and code of conduct of the organization.

## **2. Application for Membership**

- Prospective members must complete a membership form and pay the required registration fee before approval.

## **3. Approval of Membership**

- The Executive Committee reserves the right to approve or decline any membership application.

## **4. Membership Register**

- All registered members shall have their names entered in the official register of the organization.

## **5. Membership Identification**

- Each member shall be issued with an identification card or certificate as proof of membership.

## **6. Membership Dues**

- Every member shall pay annual dues and other levies agreed upon by the general body.

## **7. Attendance**

- Members must attend meetings regularly; absence without valid reason from three consecutive meetings may attract disciplinary action.

## **8. Participation**

- Members are expected to actively participate in campaigns, events, and activities of the organization.

## **9. Conduct**

- Members shall conduct themselves with discipline, respect, and integrity, upholding the good name of the organization.

## **10. Obedience to Decisions**

- All members must respect and abide by decisions taken at general meetings and by the Executive Committee.

## **11. Non-Partisanship**

- Members shall not use the organization's platform for personal, partisan political, ethnic, or religious propaganda.

## **12. Confidentiality**

- Members must keep sensitive organizational information confidential and not disclose it without authorization.

## **13. Conflict of Interest**

- A member shall declare any conflict of interest in matters concerning the organization.

## **14. Prohibition of Misuse**

- No member shall use the organization's name, resources, or influence for personal benefit.

## **15. Voluntary Service**

- Membership shall be voluntary, and contributions of time, skill, and resources shall be encouraged.

**16. Disciplinary Measures**

- A member who breaches these rules may face suspension, fines, or expulsion after fair hearing.

**17. Resignation**

- A member may resign by submitting a written notice to the Secretary, but must settle all outstanding dues.

**18. Reinstatement**

- Expelled or suspended members may be reinstated upon the recommendation of the Executive Committee and approval by the general body.

**19. Rights of Members**

- Members have the right to vote, to be elected into office, and to express opinions at meetings.

**20. Termination of Membership**

- Membership shall be terminated by death, resignation, expulsion, or dissolution of the organization.
